Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

Great Oaks Tree Services is fully committed to achieving **Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050** for its UK operations. As a regional provider of arboriculture, grounds maintenance, and environmental services, we recognise our responsibility to contribute to the UK Government's decarbonisation goals while supporting the local environment through sustainable practices.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline Year: 2024

Additional Details:

- This is our first formal Carbon Reduction Plan.
- Our 2024 baseline reflects current operations, as previous emissions were not formally recorded.
- Our focus is initially on **Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions**, with gradual inclusion of key Scope 3 elements as capacity allows.

Emissions Reduction Targets

To achieve Net Zero by 2050, Great Oaks Tree Services has set the following targets:

- **10% reduction** in total emissions by 2030 (to 51.3 tCO2e).
- **25% reduction** by 2040 (to 42.8 tCO2e).
- Net Zero by 2050 through a combination of emissions reduction and credible offsetting measures.

Progress Projection (Illustrative):

- 2024: 57 tCO2e (baseline)
- 2030: 51.3 tCO2e
- 2040: 42.8 tCO2e
- 2050: Net Zero

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

Since establishing our baseline, Great Oaks Tree Services has implemented the following initiatives:

- Vehicle Efficiency Improvements: Introduced stricter policies to reduce idling, improve driving efficiency, and service vehicles more frequently to maintain optimal performance.
- **Digital Operations:** Shifted job management, risk assessments, and client reporting to digital platforms to reduce paper consumption.
- Supply Chain Localisation: Prioritised local suppliers to minimise transport emissions.
- **Recycling & Waste Management:** Enhanced segregation and recycling of green waste and general refuse from worksites.
- **LED Lighting:** Replaced all office and workshop lighting with energy-efficient LED units.

• **Remote Working Policy:** Administrative staff allowed flexible homeworking to reduce commuting emissions.

These measures have contributed to an initial reduction of approx. 2.7 tCO2e (~5%) compared to the 2024 baseline.

Planned Future Carbon Reduction Projects

Over the next five years, Great Oaks Tree Services intends to implement:

- **Fleet Electrification:** Phased introduction of electric vans and hybrid-powered machinery where operationally viable.
- **Renewable Energy Procurement:** Switching office and workshop electricity supply to 100% renewable sources.
- **Staff Training:** Regular environmental awareness training for all staff to encourage low-carbon practices in daily operations.
- Enhanced Waste Management: Partnering with recycling firms to increase green waste conversion to biomass energy.
- **Carbon Offsetting:** Investigating verified tree planting or local offset schemes to mitigate unavoidable emissions.
- **ISO14001 Certification:** Working towards formal Environmental Management accreditation by 2028.
